WORK SESSION

The Board entered a work session to discuss:

Levy Options – Discussed HB 920 and its effect on mileage rates and the amount of money lost to this. We need to have a clear message for the levy in November – Maintain current programs with cost effective changes. Need to get more people involved. Need to develop two plans for buildings – one for passing a bond issue and one if it does not pass.

Curriculum/Instruction – Discuss different types of learning – Blended, online and dual credit. Reviewed new ratings for school and the new Teacher Evaluations and Principal Evaluations.

Student Services – Discussed the background of Special Education Law and IDEA Laws and Regulations – All students must have access to General Education.

City Representatives – Representatives from the city discussed the road widening project and how it could affect our property and entrance and egress problems. Vaguely discuss shared activity space – the tennis courts is a great example. Would like to have a joint meeting with the School Board and City Council.
