See OAC Rule 3301-51-06(H)(1). The Operating Standards do, however, require districts/schools to develop written procedures for the implementation of any method used to determine the existence of a specific learning disability which, at a minimum, incorporate guidelines developed by the Ohio Department of Education. OAC Rule 3301-51-06(H)(3)(f).

Norton City School District (IRN# 044552) has chosen to meet this obligation by using valid, reliable techniques to assess discrepancies between the child's achievement and ability, using a process based on the child's response to scientific, research-based intervention or a combination of these two methods and implementing that method in accordance with guidance set forth in Procedures and Guidance for Ohio Educational Agencies Serving Children With Disabilities at §6.7, Specific Learning Disabilities.
