Further, the affiant will be billed (and prosecuted in court if necessary) to collect all back tuition which may be due. Inaccurate and/or false information will result in immediate withdrawal of your child(ren) from Norton City Schools. The affidavit is valid for the current school year only. You will be required to prove residency again next school year if you remain in the district.
