RESIDENCY AFFIDAVIT INSTRUCTIONS

If living with another family, the attached Residency Affidavit will need to be completed for proof of residency. The homeowner fills out one form, the other form is completed by the student's parent/guardian.

COMPLETED FORMS MUST BE NOTARIZED!

Along with these notarized forms the following must also be included:

HOMEOWNER: Must provide 2 proofs of residency which may be any of the following items: a rental/lease/mortgage agreement, utility bill, voter's registration card or any government-issued document showing the homeowner's name and address.

PARENT/GUARDIAN: Must provide 2 proofs of residency which may be any of the above listed. If not available, any bills or statements showing your name and current address may be used (bank statement, insurance, medical bill, CC bill or updated driver license showing current address, etc.).

*Please notify the Enrollment Office if you feel your situation may fall under homelessness.
You will be referred to the district Homeless Liaison for further assistance.*

IMPORTANT! 2018/2019 - Homeowner could be billed \$6,020.00 tuition for falsification of information if student is found living at another address.
