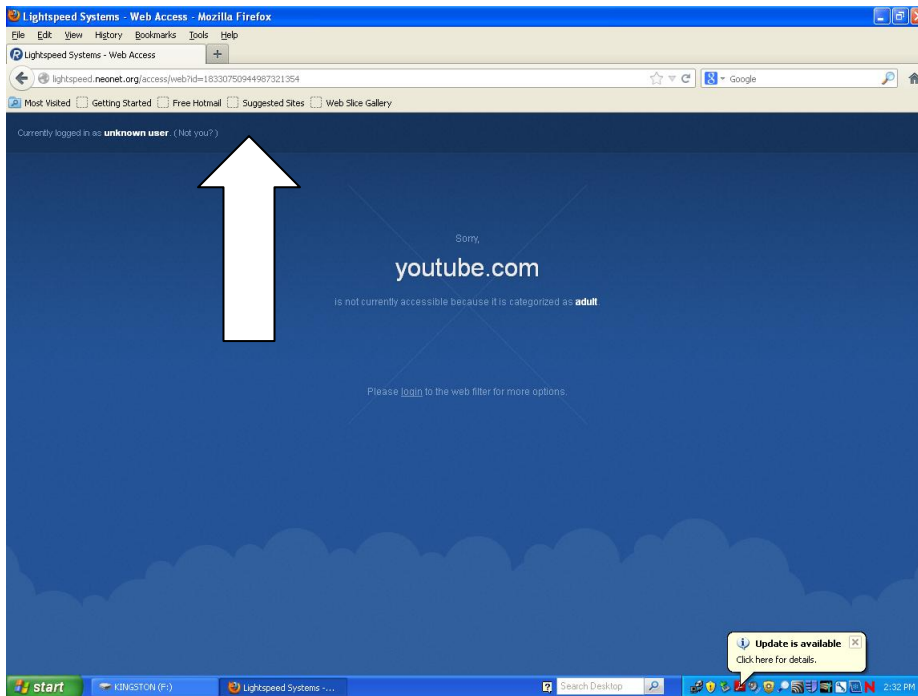


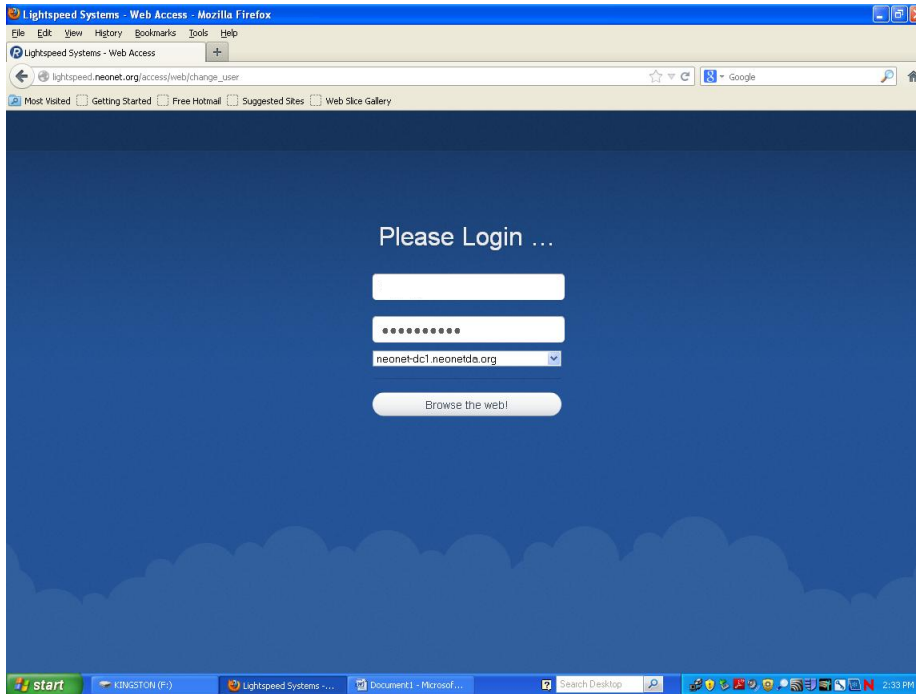
## How to Override the Filter for YouTube, Pinterest & Twitter

**\*\*\*Never have your projector on and search YouTube (or other sites you are overriding) “on the fly.” It is also recommended that you download the video rather than stream it to ensure the best quality.\*\*\***

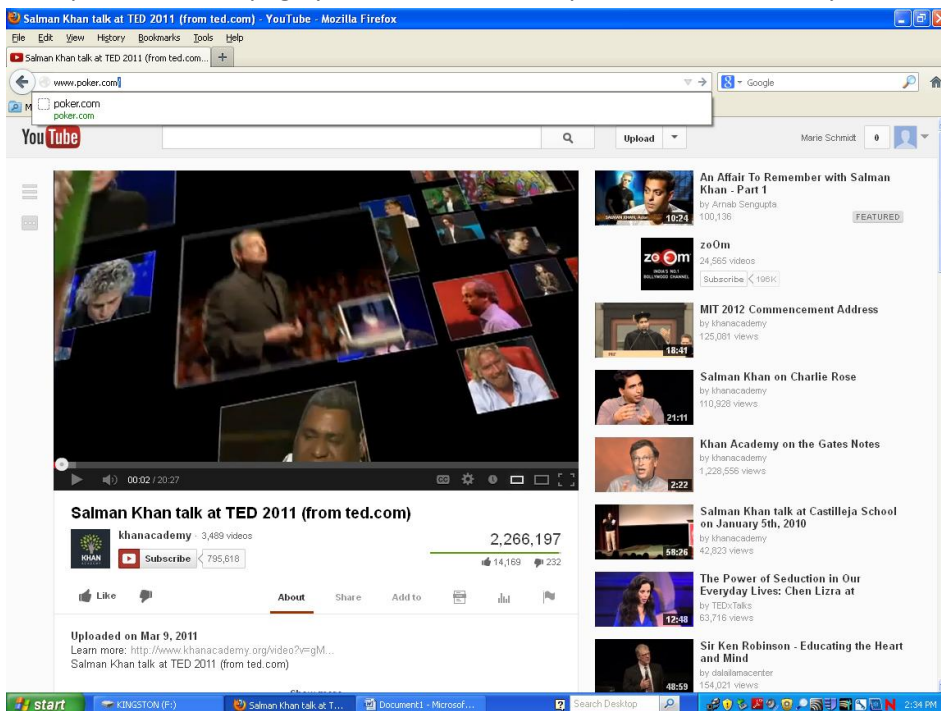
1. Go to [www.youtube.com](http://www.youtube.com) with any browser (Firefox, Chrome, or Internet Explorer).
2. When you get to the blocked page, click on the (Not you?) link in the top left corner.



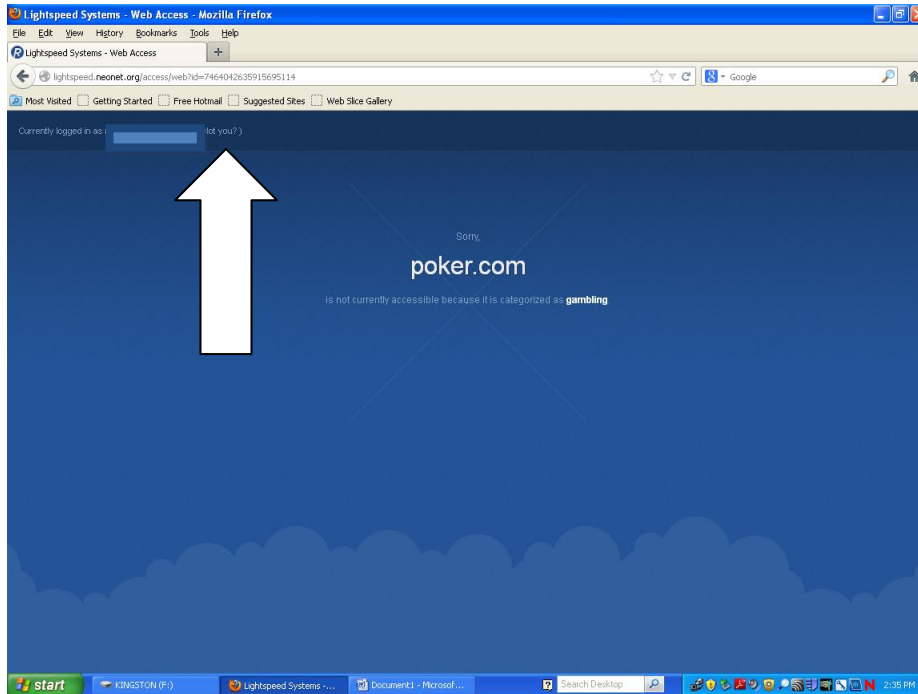
3. Log in with your email/DASL/Progress Book username and password.



4. Once you have logged in, you will get to YouTube. You can turn your projector on once you have previewed the page you need. It will be open for 1 hour. Then you will need to log in again.



5. To log out, go to [www.poker.com](http://www.poker.com) and when you see a blocked page, click on Not You (see below). This will prevent a student from getting in to YouTube on that computer.



My Big Campus is still an option for you if you would rather use that method to show YouTube videos.
