**PERSONNEL**

With the retirement of a fourth grade teacher, there has been and will be internal movement within Cornerstone School.

With the resignation of Mr. Klubnik at the High School, his position will not be replaced. Miss Christoff will transfer to teach physics and Mrs. Kovac will now teach AP classes.

Development of an evaluation tool is slated to begin in October and then it will be piloted for 2 years. High School and Middle School principals will utilize their assistants to help with the evaluations.

**CURRICULUM**

Overall the district has saved over \$17,000 in shipping charges by picking up textbook orders.

**BUILDING & GROUNDS**

Meeting with the landowners has been postponed.

In discussion with City Officials, they would like the schools to move from the corner lots.

**PUBLIC RELATIONS**

A discussion was held regarding the Superintendent's notes and getting all information out to the public at Community meetings. When a position is vacated, we will assess the job before filling the position.

**TRANSPORTATION**

Drivers will have to do "safety" speech for each field/athletic trip. We will also need to look at the Transportation Secretary's job.

**FINANCE**

Vision insurance will be offered to the teaching staff.

The district has a net total of 302 open enrollment – 382 students coming into the district and 80 will be leaving the district.

The Superintendent is checking with the Ohio Schools Facilities Commission regarding our state share. Our number on the equity listing has decreased from 400 to 372

resulting in our opportunity to take advantage of the plan a year sooner then estimated and it changed our state share percentage from 34% to 39%-- an increase of 5%.
