- A. Approve Senate Bill 1, Section 4 of the 134th General Assembly, signed by Governor DeWine on or about October 28, 2021 and deemed immediately effective under the General Assembly's emergency powers, the Norton City Schools Board of Education authorizes the employment of substitute teachers, as-needed, who do not hold a post-secondary degree, as otherwise required pursuant to Ohio law and regulations, including Ohio Revised Code 3301.071, 3319.226, 3319.30, and 3319.36, Ohio Administrative

Code Section 3301-23-44, and/or Board Policy, provided that all other applicable requirements and procedures, including but not limited to successful completion of a criminal background check and evidence of a non-renewable temporary substitute teaching license issued by the Ohio Department of Education, have been satisfied.

This is a temporary resolution of the Norton City School Board of Education, and the authority granted by this resolution extends from the effective date through June 30, 2022.

V. SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATIONS

- A. Approve the increase in Certified (teacher) Substitute pay from \$85 per day to \$100 and the daily rate for days six through sixty consecutive position from \$90 per day to \$105 and an additional \$5 for retired Norton teachers.
