Welcome back to the Norton City Schools Lunch and Breakfast Program for the 2020-2021 school year. Our Food Service Department is made up of a team of food and nutrition professionals that are dedicated to student's health, well-being and their ability to learn. We will be serving healthy choices of fruits, vegetables, whole grain products and low fat or fat-free milk every day.

The lunch prices for the 2020/2021 school year are as follows:

Pre School K-4	\$2.60	Breakfast	\$1.75
High & Middle School	\$2.85	Reduced Breakfast	\$.30
Grades K-12 Reduced	\$.40		
Milk	\$.50	Adult Lunch	\$3.75

We encourage you to look into PaySchools Central that provides all parents in our district an easy way to manage their child's lunch account. This can all be done in the convenience of your own home through an easy-to-use online portal: www.payschoolscentral.com or via a convenient mobile app.

Logging onto PaySchools, you will be able to deposit money at your convenience, check your child's balance and other features. You need only create one account to manage all members of your family. Once the money is deposited, it will typically appear in your child's account in **24 hours**.

If you choose not to use PaySchools Central for credit card transactions, the district continues to accept cash and checks at each school cafeteria. Please watch for any pink slips coming home with your child with low balance information on it. Do not combine lunch money with other school fees on the same check or money order. We do not give change back for any checks that are sent for school lunches.

Please consider filling out your **Free and Reduced application** online. Visit www.nortonschools.org and under the District Tab choose Food Services. Click on the icon "QuikApps" towards the bottom of the page to create an account or to sign in to complete the form for the new school year. Our on-line application has the same requirements, asking you for the same information as the paper application. You will find out immediately once completing the application on-line if you are approved for free or reduced meals. Paper applications are still available if needed. You only need to fill out one application for all students living in your household no matter what school they attend. If you received a letter, stating your student is eligible for Direct Certification **YOU DO NOT** need to fill out an application. Applications are accepted anytime during the school year.
