Preschool Program

The preschool program is guided by curriculum, written policies and regulations of the District that are consistent with applicable statutory requirements contained in State law. Resources of the preschool program include, but are not limited to:

- 1. staff;
- 2. cumulative records;
- 3. health and safety;
- 4. admission;
- 5. attendance and discipline;
- 6. selection and use of developmentally appropriate materials, equipment and resources that meet the intellectual, physical, social and emotional needs of the preschool student;
- 7. management of communicable diseases and
- 8. transportation and field trips.

Prospective employees meeting certain criteria set forth in State law must be tested for tuberculosis.

NOTE: State law permits any school district to establish a preschool program, not just those school districts that are eligible for povertybased assistance.

House Bill 210 (2021) requires testing for tuberculosis for prospective employees meeting certain criteria. It prohibits a program from employing a person who tests positive for active tuberculosis from being employed until the person submits evidence of completing treatment and no longer being positive for active tuberculosis. It permits a program to employ a person who tests positive for latent tuberculosis so long as the person receives treatment and submits periodic evidence of complying with the treatment regimen.
