

Recommendations for the Locally Adopted Graduation Seals

Community Service Seal: Complete a community service project aligned with the guidelines adopted by the student's local board of education or the school's governing authority.

Recommendation: Currently students must complete 10 hours of community service for the Ambassador Program. Maintain this at 10 hours and award students the Community Service Seal.

Fine and Performing Arts Seal: Demonstrate skill in the fine or performing arts according to an evaluation aligned with guidelines adopted by the student's local board of education or the school's governing authority.

Recommendations: Complete 3 credit hours of band, choir, or art.

Student Engagement Seal: Participate in extracurricular activities such as athletics, clubs, or student government to a meaningful extent, as determined by guidelines adopted by the student's local board of education or the school's governing authority.

Recommendations:

-Athletics: Student participates in three years of the same sport.

-Clubs: Student participates in three years of the same club - board approved and the advisor is a paid supplemental position. The club advisor will complete an evaluative tool to determine level of participation and student eligibility.

-Plays: Student participates in 3 plays. The play advisor will complete an evaluative tool to determine level of participation and student eligibility.
