

Senior Picture Requirements 2018-2019 Nortonian

The Nortonian will have an open system for senior portraits, which means seniors can submit portraits from their choice of photographers. However, you must adhere to several guidelines in order for us to publish the photo in the yearbook.

The portrait must be submitted:

- No later than **April 1, 2019**
- Digitally, via email to **LCascaldo@nortonschools.org** with **SENIOR PORTRAIT** in the subject line, as an **ATTACHMENT**, not in the body of the email
- On a flash drive, or CD

Submissions must be made in the following format:

- 2.25 x 3 inch
- Color
- DPI 300
- .JPEG or .JPG format ONLY
- At least 400 x 600 pixels

Style:

- A headshot style **ONLY** will be considered for publication. (picture from the chest up- upright only.)
- Your hands must not be visible
- No extreme close ups
- No props
- No hats



Q: What if I have a friend photograph me?

Follow the guidelines above. There is no guarantee the photo will be in the yearbook if the photographer (professional or amateur) does not meet the guidelines listed here.

Q: What will happen if I do not turn in a senior picture at all?

It's possible we will use your school picture, taken at the beginning of the school year, unless it does not adhere to the guidelines listed here. If that isn't available, your portrait will not appear in the yearbook.

Q: What happens if I don't meet the deadline of April 1?

Your portrait will not be in the yearbook.

Q: Can I have my photo taken outdoors?

Yes, but it **MUST** adhere to the same guidelines listed above – no hands visible, head and chest only, no extreme close ups, no props or hats.
