2024-2025

- Ohio Districts and schools receive funds to support initiatives that provide wraparound services for Ohio's students.
- Recent updates have been put into place to ensure districts are positioned to prioritize students' physical and mental health needs through partnerships.

Requirements for Funds

50%	At least 50% of the SWSF have to be spent on physical and/or mental health services
Share	Share the information with the governing board and post to the district website.
Report	Annually report how the district spent the funds
Spend	Funds must be spent by the end of the next fiscal year after they are received.
