Voting Method

All votes taken by the Board are recorded in the official proceedings of the meeting.

To comply fully with State law, roll-call votes are made on resolutions pertaining to:

- 1. any action on which a Board member requests a roll-call vote and
- 2. re-employment of a teacher against the Superintendent's recommendation.

The following actions require a roll-call vote and an affirmative vote by a majority of the full membership of the Board for passage:

- 1. purchase or sale of real or personal property;
- 2. employment of any school employee;
- 3. election or appointment of an officer;
- 4. payment of any debt or claim and
- 5. adoption of any textbook.

For passage, most other actions require an affirmative vote by a majority of those present either physically or electronically (i.e. by teleconference, video conference, or any other similar electronic technology) and voting. Board members must be physically present or electronically present (i.e. by teleconference, video conference, or any other similar electronic technology) at the meeting in order to vote.

All votes which require a specific majority are in the exhibit which follows.

Electronic voting and presence effective until July 1, 2021, per Ohio House Bill 197, Section 12.
