- 9:30 PM Arrive back at school with many fond memories.

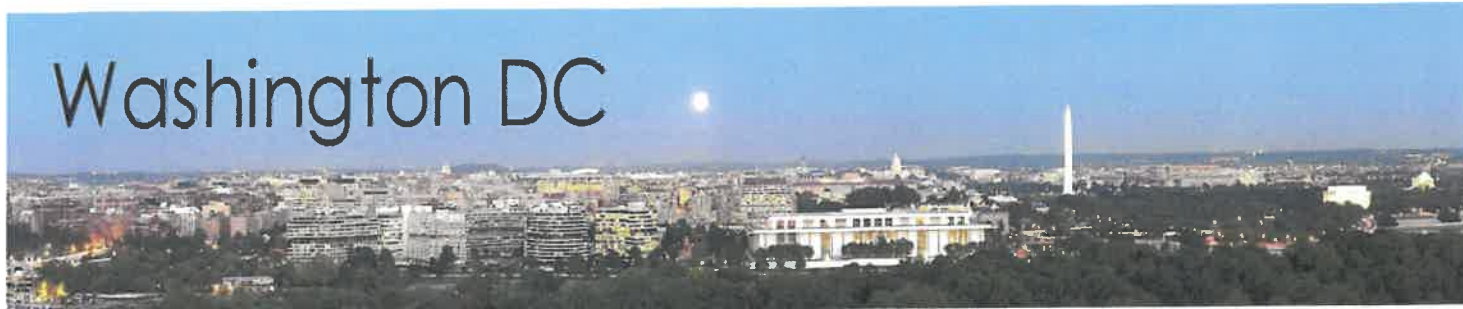
